### **Bowen Island Featured on CTV's 'TASTE OF HOME'**

Bowen Island will be featured on the CTV series, 'Taste of Home'. The twenty-six part series features Canadian regions from coast to coast. It began in the spring of 1999 on the east coast and featured Cape Breton fiddler, Natalie McMaster. Bowen was the twenty-fifth stop for the production crew and will feature Bowen's own master fiddler, Moritz Behm. It will also feature the art of Ian Fry and photographer Allan de la Plante. The crew quietly slipped onto Bowen in January, with English host, Sandi Stahlbrand and French host, Richare Garneau.

Garneau is legendary as the voice of the Montreal Canadiens. He was inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame along with Wayne Gretzky.

The crew stuck around for three days and got some wonderful footage of Bowen on one of those great sunny winter days. An exceptional high-wind, high-tide sequence, was taken of Moritz near Finister Island.

The show will air on CTV Saturday, March 4 at 1pm.
